### The Past Continuous - Perfect English Grammar

Past continuous tense – The past continuous or past progressive tense is used to indicate that an action was happening or going on at some point in time in the past – past meaning it came to an end. This tense is formed by combining the auxiliary verb 'to be' in past (was, were) with the verb's present participle ending in '-ing'.
